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Project Goal

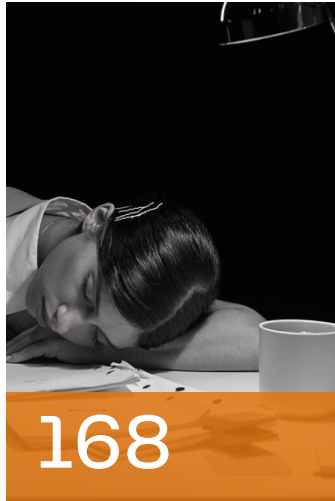
Educators who seek to pass on a Catholic worldview will have the tools to do so with confidence.

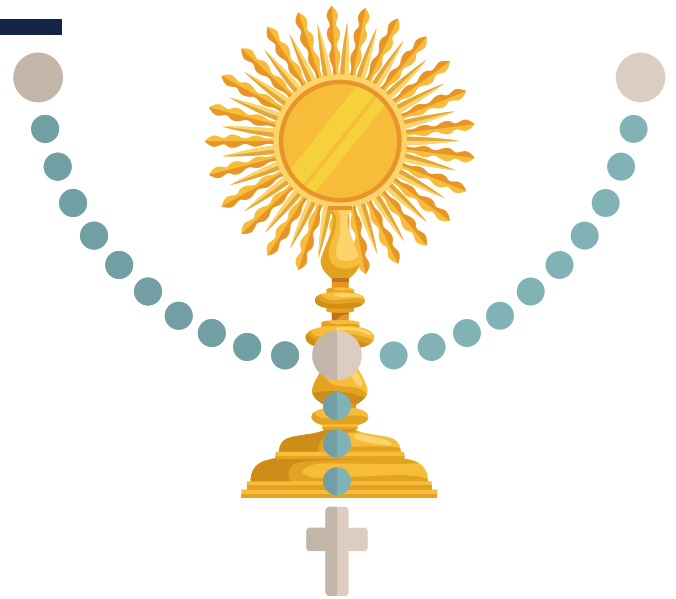

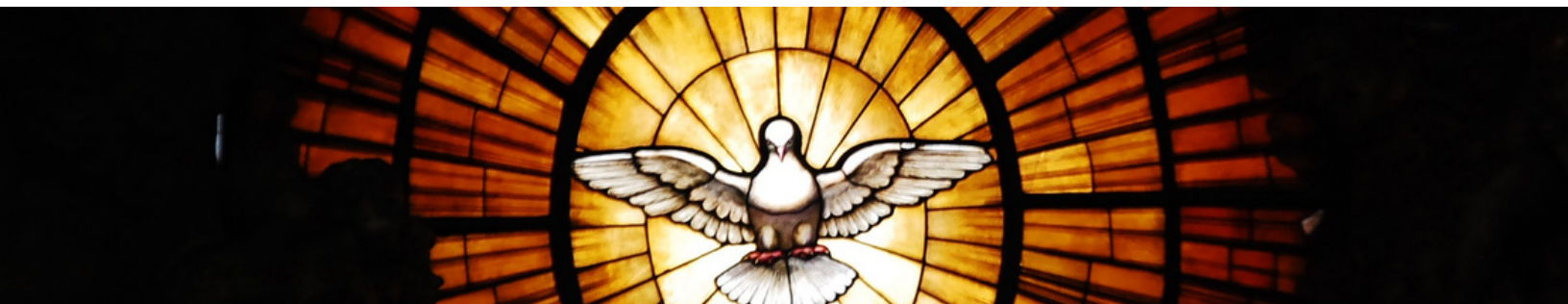
